Learning to be a safe and defensive driver will be one of the most important skills acquired during your teen's adolescence. Good skills and habits developed during their formal driving instruction will last a lifetime. Green Light Driving Academy's goal is to promote safe and meaningful instruction for teen drivers in North Texas.

Course Tuition fee- Complete course (Classroom & Driving Instruction) \$440.00.

Discounts for returning families, active military personnel, first responders (Police, EMS, Fire) and other special offers or coupon discounts may be offered throughout the year (some restrictions apply). A contract must be completed and payment made to guarantee enrollment in the class.

ADDITIONAL COSTS (Not part of the course tuition)-

1. **Drive Lesson Scheduling fee- \$14.95 (one-time fee)** is payable to Schedule 2 Drive.
2. **Instruction Permit Fee- \$16.00** payable to the TX Dept. of Public Safety (DPS), cash, check or credit card accepted.

COURSE CONTENT- The teenage driver education course at Green Light Driving Academy meets the state of Texas requirements for teen driver education. The course has two phases, Classroom = 32 hours & In-car = 14 hours (7 hours behind-the-wheel & 7 hours observing) ([Classroom Only & Drive Only information](#))

PARENT ORIENTATION- A Parent Orientation session is held on the first or second day of class (date noted on contract) and typically lasts about an hour. The purpose of the parent orientation is to provide information to parents about state laws that govern teen drivers, the instruction permit process and the procedures of Green Light Driving Academy. It is **HIGHLY** suggested that at least one parent attend.

PHASE I – CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION- Class size is limited to 36 students. A minimum enrollment may be required for certain classes during the year. Please be prepared to provide an alternate date/time in the event that a class cancelled.

- Class sessions are scheduled for 2 hours per day for 16 days. (Depending on time of year- either 3 weeks Monday – Friday plus one Saturday or 4 weeks Monday – Thursday, no Fridays or weekends. Alternative class schedules are offered during Christmas & Spring Break).
- Classroom Instruction includes the following:
 1. **Instruction Permit testing:** After 6 hours of instruction, students are given the written DPS permit test. Upon passing the test, students are issued a DE-964 certificate, along with other required documents, allows the student to obtain the instruction permit from a DPS office.
 2. **Drug and Alcohol Driving Awareness Program (DADAP):** The state approved course is included and a certificate of completion is issued at the completion of the entire driver education course. This certificate may be used to obtain an additional 5% discount on auto insurance for the student driver. (Check with auto insurance agent for availability.)
 3. **Make-up Classes-** Students may miss up to 5 classroom sessions. Any missed session must be made up by attending a future classroom session for that day. (Absent on Day 6, attend Day 6 make-up in the future). (No charge for attending the make-up session) Please check our website for more details.

PHASE II – BEHIND-THE-WHEEL INSTRUCTION- consisting of 7- two (2) hour lessons. 7 hours of in-car, behind-the-wheel instruction & 7 hours of in-car observation (with a GLDA instructor) is scheduled after the student has completed the scheduled classroom session. All in-car lessons must be scheduled using the Schedule2Drive online scheduling system.

- **30 hour parent Log-** Students are required to log 30 hours of driving with their parents) or another driver that is over 21 years of age. (10 of the 30 hours must be driven at night.) This is **in addition** to the 14 hours required with GLDA instructors (see above). These hours can begin once the student has the learner' permit and will be logged on the "Schedule2Drive" site after the account is created.

COMPLETION OF COURSE- Upon completion of the 32 hours of classroom instruction, 14 hours in-car instruction with GLDA instructors, 30 parent log hours, the course completion certificate (form DE-964) is issued to the student. **Most insurance companies offer a 10% discount on auto insurance with the successful completion of our course.**

Students may obtain their Class C TX driver's license after:

1. DE-964 completion certificate has been issued
2. student is at least 16 years of age
3. student has held instruction permit at least 180 days
4. student has completed the Impact Texas Teen Driver's course (ITTD)
5. student passes a DPS Road Test, at a DPS location or with Green Light Driving Academy
